ABOUT THE STANDARDBRED ASSOCIATION QLD INC (SAQ)

The Standardbred Association Queensland Inc (SAQ) was founded in 1998, and was primarily established as the States Standardbred Breed Society. It became evident that there was a shortfall for opportunities for Standardbreds retiring from racing, with a large majority of them finding themselves in slaughter yards.

In 2002, the SAQ started their Adoption and Rehoming Program, which was the first Not for Profit Association in Queensland to focus specifically on retraining and rehoming retired racehorses. Over the past 16 years, the program has steadily grown along with the racing industry's awareness of the importance of retirement options for its retired athletes, and we have rehomed over 1000 Standardbreds through our adoption program.

The Standardbred Association Qld Inc (SAQ) aims to increase the demand for retired Standardbred racehorses as pleasure and performance horses. This is being done through the SAQ Standardbred Horse Adoption Program. The adopted horses have successfully transitioned into both Pleasure and Performance Homes on their retirement from their traditional role of Harness Racing. The SAQ runs and sponsors many shows, events and clinics, shares success stories, and actively promotes the attributes of the breed. It is actively educating the community about the various life beyond racing options, versatility of use, and the appropriate care and retraining of racehorses.




